

## **CODE2 Improved Functional Outcome Assessment for ACL Repair**

Percentage of patients aged 18 years and older with primary anterior cruciate ligament repair who completed baseline and follow-up (patient-reported) functional status assessments that reported a non-trivial improvement in functional status.

### **DENOMINATOR:**

#### **Denominator criteria (Eligible Cases):**

Patients with patient-reported functional status assessment results not more than 180 days prior to the primary anterior cruciate ligament repair procedure, and at least 60 days and not more than 180 days after the procedure.

#### **Denominator Exclusions:**

Patients with multiple traumas at the time of the procedure or patients with severe cognitive impairment.

### **NUMERATOR:**

Patients with patient-reported functional status assessment results not more than 180 days prior to the primary anterior cruciate ligament repair procedure, and at least 60 days and not more than 180 days after the procedure that demonstrated at least a 10% increase in their functional outcomes.
